HIV CARE SERVICES

The Champaign-Urbana Public Health District is a contractor of the Illinois Department of Public Health.

The division of Infectious Disease Prevention and Management oversees a program which was established by Title II of the Ryan White Comprehensive AIDS Resource Emergency Care Act. The goal of the program is to improve quality, availability, and organization of health care and support services for individuals living with HIV Disease. The East Central Illinois Care Consortium provides services to the counties of Champaign, Coles, DeWitt, Douglas, Edgar, Ford, Iroquois, Kankakee, Livingston, Piatt & Vermilion

HIV SERVICES OFFERED THROUGH THE CONSORTIUM

Case Management, Oral Health Care, Housing Services, Utility Assistance, Primary Medical Care, Nutrition Services, Vaccination Programs, Transportation Assistance, Mental Health Services and Legal Assistance

The East Central Illinois HIV Care Consortium is to be used as a payer or last resort. This means that clients must first apply for and/or use other available resources like food banks, public housing, township, public aid, utility assistance, etc. to meet their needs before they become eligible for benefits from the consortium.
