

Do You Qualify for KidCare/FamilyCare?

IF...

Your children are 18 years or younger, residents of Illinois and U.S. citizens or Legal immigrants, or you are pregnant and a resident of Illinois – OR – you are a parent Living with children or relatives who care for children in place of their parents*

THEN...

Check to see if you meet the income guidelines by following the steps below.

A) Add up your total monthly employment earnings (before taxes) And other monthly income. \$ _____

B) Add up the following:

- Monthly day care expenses (up to a maximum of \$200 per child under age 2 and \$175 per child 2 and over).
- Monthly child support RECEIVED (up to \$50).
- Monthly child support PAID.
- \$90 for each adult with income from a job. \$ _____

C) Now subtract B from A for your estimated KC/FC income. \$ _____
