I imagine some of the victims have post-traumatic stress syndrome and we know that PTSD is amplified if one has had a traumatic childhood. This is what our program deals with. If those in attendance at the seminar would like to take our 25-week class, "Learning to Live, Learning to Love", we would find sponsors/scholarships for them. The class would normally cost at the lowest sliding scale, \$550. We would waive all costs for them. If they plan to be here for 6 months or so, this could be an added "blessing in disguise", as they may not have sought out such a class on their own. It would also be a good weekly support system for them. The classes are gender separate and become almost a 2nd family to some. I know from personal experience, it can be life changing on the emotional/identity/self-esteem level. Please let me know if you think this has any merit or is feasible. Thanks.
